2. Matters arising from previous minutes:-

The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed as correct and signed by Margaret Patten (chair).

Treasurer report:-

Current account: £ 6,442

Reserve account: £ 5623

Bookings report:-

Richard reported that the normal regular winter bookings are going well and everything is in order. In January we always review the hire prices, it was decided to fix the prices – NO CHANGE.

Extension project report:-

“Build-It” have started work on the new ladies toilets and the separate bar area. As is normal, 2.5% of the final payment to be held back for snagging.

A discussion was had about the new men’s toilet, when should work commence? It was decided that the work be done during the winter once we have the money, thus winter 2009/2010 has been pencilled in.

User group reports:-

Croyde Players

A discussion was had with regard to Croyde Players ‘secret’ doors!. It was decided to go ahead with these (with Croyde Players picking up the bill). It was noted and agreed that Croyde Players only had two requirements from the new extension project: Good free access to additional changing rooms and a separate toilet. Neither of these was done.
